General Practice Data for Planning and Research: NHS Digital Transparency Notice

How and why NHS Digital collects, analyses, publishes and shares data collected from GP practices for planning and research.

The Drive Surgery is one of many organisations working in the health and care system to improve care for patients and the public.

Under data protection law we must tell you about how NHS use your personal information. This includes the personal information that NHS collect from and share with other organisations and why. NHS do this through Transparency/Privacy Notices. This additional Transparency Notice provides details about the personal information that GP practices are sharing with NHS under NHS General Practice Data for Planning and Research data collection.

Your personal confidential data will be extracted and shared with NHS Digital in order to support vital health and care planning and research.
